Testimony on the following bills during week of February 22-26

HB2411 K-2, BZP, and TFMPP

SB520 Prisoner pay for work after conviction. Testimony was not provided at hearing but follow-up letter was submitted due to committee discussion to change the rate paid in another section of the bill which would impact local budgets where prisoners are allowed to work prior to conviction.

HB2685 CCW Testimony in opposition.

SB480 License Tags – No testimony planned but comments were provided in regards to discussion on license plate frames and in response to some questions they had regarding misdemeanor versus traffic infraction.

Legislative Schedule

The next legislative deadline is Wednesday, March 24. All bills must be passed by the second chamber by this date.

1. [SB48](#) (911 Funding): Further discussions were held this week by the Senate Utilities Committee subcommittees. The plan is to have numerous amendment proposals to discuss on Monday and to take final action on Tuesday.
2. [SB375](#) (Repeal of Capital Punishment): There has been no action to revive this bill this week.
3. [SB458](#) (Forensic testimony by video): This bill was assigned to the House Corrections and Juvenile Justice Committee. No hearing has been set yet.
4. [HB2454](#) (Sentencing enhancement for felons wearing ballistic vest): KBI Support for local law enforcement: This bill has been referred to the Senate Judiciary Committee but no hearing has been set yet.
5. Retirement bills: No action this week on any of our retirement bills.
